She is the coauthor, with Hans Eysenck, of *Psychoticism as a Dimension of Personality and Personality Structure and Measurement* and the co-editor, with Donald Saklofske, of *Individual Differences in Children and Adolescents*, published by Transaction.

Toxic Cyanobacteria in Water Sep 27 2020 Cyanobacterial toxins are among the hazardous substances most widely found in water. Recognizing that bullying behavior is a major public health problem that demands the concerted and coordinated time and attention of parents, educators and school administrators, health care providers, policy makers, families, and others concerned with the care of children, this report evaluates the state of the science on biological and psychosocial consequences of peer victimization and the risk and protective factors that either increase or decrease peer victimization behavior and consequences.
